Inflation Report, August 2017

A. Domestic Inflation

In August 2017, Phnom Penh Consumer Price Index increased by 0.4% compared to previous month, and increased by 2.6% compared to one year before.

In August 2017, price levels of most product groups increased compared to the previous month. Price level of Transport increased by 1.4%, in which gasoline price increased 3.1% and diesel price by 1.1%. Price levels of foods and nonalcoholic beverages, clothing and footwear, and restaurant, due to price rises of rice (0.2%), meat (0.7%), vegetable (1,1%), cooking oil (2.6%), clothing (0.9%) and garment raw material (1.4%) items.

In comparison to one year before, price level growth of most product groups reversed up after slowing down in June and July. Price level of food and nonalcoholic beverage rose by 2.8%, price level of alcoholic beverage and tobacco rose by 1.3%, price level of clothing and footwear rose by 3.5% and price level of transport rose by 4.2%.

As per regression estimation until December 2017, inflation rate year-on-year is approximately 2.0%, and year average inflation rate is approximately 2.9%.

- The Price Indices are compiled by geometric average
