



# State Budget Implementation

April, 2024

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## 1. Executive Summary of TOFE

**In April 2024, the Budgetary Central Government (BCG) collected 2,354 billion riels in domestic revenue, equivalent to 8.06% of the 2024 annual budget law (BL), while its expenditure reached 3,005 billion riels, equivalent to 9.78% of the 2024 BL. As a result, BCG's budget execution has a 722 billion riels deficit.**

**The four months of 2024, BCG collected 2,354 billion riels in domestic revenue, equivalent to 8.06% of the 2024 BL** similar to the same period last year in which consisting of 2,041 billion riels in tax revenue, equivalent to 7.92% of the 2024 BL and 200 billion riels in non-tax revenue, equivalent to 13.43% of the 2024 BL.

**In April 2024, BCG's expenditure reached 3,005 billion riels, equivalent to 9.78% of the 2024 BL, a 1.06% increase compared to the same period last year,** consisting of 2,074 billion riels in current expenditure, equivalent to 8.72%% of the 2024 BL contributing to a decrease of 2.38%, and 931 billion riels in capital expenditure, equivalent to 13.43% of the 2024 BL. Overall, BCG's expenditure execution continues to maintain the principle of restricting unnecessary expenditures and allocating budgets to implement proactive objectives.

**The Royal Government continues to manage and utilize BCG's total financing effectively and carefully, which has allowed the need for budget execution to be met in a timely manner.** Foreign financing achieved 74 billion riels equivalent to 54.67% of the 2024 BL and domestic financing achieved 486 billion riels equivalent to 67.30% of the 2024 BL.






### Revenue and Trade Relate Tax 2023-2024




### Tax and Non Tax Revenue 2023-2024



### Current Expenditures and Domestic Financing 2023-2024




### Wage and Non-wage 2023-2024




